HURRICANE

Towering 12m into the air, 11m arms have a car at the bottom of each carrying 4 people, sitting side by side in pairs.

The ride starts off at a slow spin, propelling the arms upward. The speed is increased until the cars are almost in line with the top of the tower. Then the operator will begin to "bounce" the arms by releasing the compressed air resulting in the arms dropping quickly with a loud burst of air. A real sensation of weightlessness. This is repeated a number of times.

AREA REQUIRED:	20 metre diameter x 12 metres high
POWER REQUIRED:	32 amp 3 phase
SUITABLE FOR:	People 110cm and over
CAPACITY:	24 riders at a time
TURNOVER:	288 people per hour
